Recipe of the Month

LOVE BUG TACOS

Love Bug Tacos are such a fun and creative way to celebrate Valentine's Day with the kids. They're adorable, easy to make, and guaranteed to bring big smiles to the dinner table.

Ingredients:

- 8 small soft tortillas
- 1 pound ground beef or turkey
- 1 packet taco seasoning
- 1 cup shredded lettuce
- 1 cup diced tomatoes
- 1 cup shredded cheese
- 1/2 cup black olives (sliced)
- Sour cream (for decoration)
- Red heart shaped candy



Instructions:

1. In a skillet over medium heat, cook the ground meat until browned. Drain excess fat and add taco seasoning according to the package. Stir in water and simmer for a few minutes.
2. Warm the tortillas in a separate pan or microwave.
3. To assemble, place a spoonful of taco meat in the center of each tortilla.
4. Let the kids add shredded lettuce, diced tomatoes, and cheese.
5. For the love bug effect, use black olives for the eyes and a dollop of sour cream for a smile. Add heart shaped candies for the ears (antenna).
6. Serve immediately and let the kids enjoy their creations!



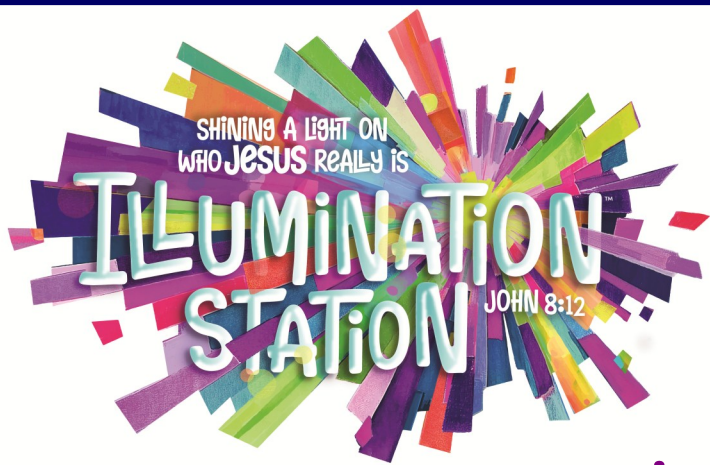
"THE TUNNEL OF LOVE" MARRIAGE EVENT

4. What are some of the names of the people with you?
5. What did you read from the Bible?
6. Did anything make you laugh?
7. What was your favorite activity?
8. What are you looking forward to at church next time?
9. How is Jesus connected to the story you learned today?
10. Did you start memorizing a verse from the Bible?

Follow up:

- What verse? (If they recite the verse, don't worry if they don't remember all of it. See if you can help them find the verse and practice it later.)
- What does the verse mean?
